**ORDER ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY COURTHOUSE**

Upon written motion and for good cause shown, the Court hereby finds the Motion for Temporary Emergency Courthouse to be well taken, finding the ongoing medical emergency presented by the COVID-19 pandemic threatens the orderly operation of this Court and necessitates the designation of a temporary emergency courthouse.

**THEREFORE, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS**, pursuant to the powers granted to it in R.C. 2301.04(A), that training room located in the basement at 100 Executive Drive, Marion, Ohio, shall be declared a temporary courthouse for purposes of sheriff sale and auditor sale. Should the larger Harding Room or Memorial Room become available, those rooms shall be included in this Order if previously scheduled events are canceled.

This Order shall be in effect from 8:30 a.m. August 6, 2020 through 5:00 p.m. August 6, 2020 and shall be withdrawn by function of this same Order at 5:00 p.m. August 6, 2020. The Court's current location at 100 North Main Street, Marion, Ohio shall continue to function as courthouse during this time, as shall any other Orders declaring temporary courthouse locations in effect during this time. This Order shall be posted on the Court's website at least 30 days from the date of its filing.
