This matter is before the Court sua sponte, in order to comply with Revised Code 2301.04. This Court previously ordered that the Harding Room of 100 Executive Drive, Marion Ohio shall be deemed a courthouse for the purposes of holding a Jury trial and deliberations in the above cases, beginning at 8:00am on Tuesday October 20th, 2020. Such temporary courthouse will no longer be necessary as the State of Ohio moved to dismiss 19cr544 and such motion was granted. Further the State of Ohio requested a continuance of trial in 20cr258 and such motion was granted.

The Court having no further need on October 20th for the additional space provided at 100 Executive Dr. in the above cases, hereby **ORDERS** its previous order filed September 29th, 2020 in the above captioned case numbers establishing the temporary courthouse location, rescinded, effective immediately as it applies to the above captioned cases. Future proceedings in the above matters shall be conducted at The County Courthouse located at 100 N. Main St., Marion Ohio. This order SHALL NOT be deemed to impact any order in any other case or matter which establishes a

temporary courthouse location.

This order shall be posted on the Court's website for a period of at least 30 days from its filing.
